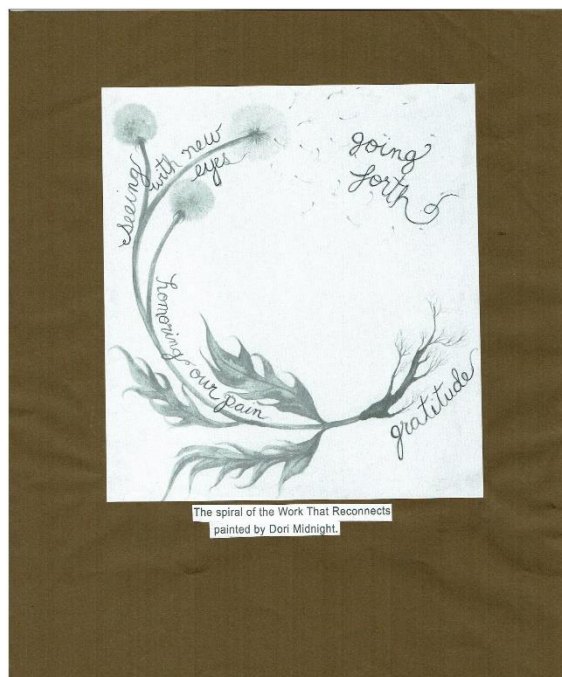


# Quakers & Climate
